NARORA ATOMIC POWER STATION

Narora Atomic Power Station (NAPS) is one of the operating units of NPCIL and consists of two Reactors supplying the steam to two Turbo Generators of 220 MW each. It is located on the banks of holy Ganges. The station is connected to high voltage network through five 220 KV lines. The reactors at NAPS are PHWR type Reactors. PHWR is a horizontal pressure tube Heavy Water Reactors. The plant is situated about 60 km from Aligarh which is the nearest population centre. NAPS, Narora, lies in the district of Bulandshahr, UP, and is about 60 km from Bulandshahr city. The nearby Railway Station is Aligarh Junction as well as Rajghat-Narora (which is on Aligarh-Bareilly branch line). Public/Private buses/Transportation from Aligarh, Agra, Bulandshahr, Delhi (Anand Vihar ISBT) & NCR, Mathura, Moradabad along with Budaun, are plying to Narora.
